

## **AVCNA Rotation Bid Guidelines**

The AVCNA Rotation will be in a 3-year rotation with Hampton Roads, Richmond and Roanoke. The convention hotels will be selected by the VRCC. Any Area of the Central Atlantic Region can host the AVCNA in any one of these locations. The following are guidelines to be completed to bid for the AVCNA. If two (20) Areas would like to cohost, each cohosting Area would need to complete these guidelines.

- An Area Group Conscience in favor of hosting the AVCNA.
- An Area letter of support from a surrounding Area to host the AVCNA.

Area or Areas bidding for the AVCNA are to notify the VRCC of their intention in the March VRCC meeting, 22 months before said AVCNA. All bids must be completed and submitted in the May VRCC meeting, 20 months before the AVCNA. VRCC will ask for a director vote to accept the bid in the May VRCC meeting.

Any complete bids not accepted will be held for the following year.

Motion 9-4-24: To approve the proposed AVCNA Rotation Guidelines, to replace current Bidding Guidelines

Intent: To support our Directors decisions to develop the AVCNA Rotation, to have the new bidding guidelines in place for 43rd AVCNA in January 2027. Bids for the 43rd will need to be presented in May 2025. Per current policy, bid guidelines are to be mailed out to areas in November twenty six months prior to the convention.
